ELIGIBILITY

Projects by all AIA San Fernando Valley Chapter members, without respect to project location and projects by AIA members of any Chapter when the project lies within the San Fernando Valley Chapter boundaries (Includes all of Los Angeles County north of Mulholland Drive and west of Glendale Blvd. The communities of Valencia, Santa Clarita and Antelope Valley are a part of our boundaries.)

Categories will be created as appropriate for the entries received from

20-Year Award

Recognizing projects of enduring design quality, completed prior to the end of the 2003 calendar year. Submission of at least one (1) photographic slide taken at time of original completion of project with an accompanying current condition views.

AIA / San Fernando Valley Firm Award

Recognizing a body of work by a single firm (or its successors), including at least five (5) projects executed over a period of at least ten (10) years. Firms may nominate themselves.

Best Client

Recognizing a client who has supported the architect in the execution of an exceptional design of a project or a body of work built in the past five (5) years. Client to have actively participated with the architect in the design process to expand new ideas for the betterment of the community. Describe how the client inspired / influenced design decisions and submit slides of project(s).

Building Team of the Year Award

Acknowledging a project team that demonstrated strong collaboration to achieve design excellence. The team may include clients, architects, contractors, consultants, developers, and public agencies.

DEADLINES

Submissions must be received through by 11:59 pm on August 5, 2024.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Drawings and images. Includes photographs, sketches, site plans or other visual information illustrating the project. A PowerPoint file with an aspect ratio of 16x9. There is a maximum of 10 slides. File size of PowerPoint is limited to less than 15MB. PowerPoint template is provided.

Images should be full bleed. Images with huge borders are difficult to judge and will work against getting an award.

Expanded Project Statement. This narrative should describe how the project fulfills the 10 points of Framework for Design Excellence where possible.

Requirements of Winners

Award recipients will be notified by email no later than the week of October 1, 2024.

Winners will be required to provide one (1) 20" x 30" display board and permission for publication of photographs.

FEES

Early Bird Submissions:

- \$200.00 per entry, non-refundable for AIA/San Fernando Valley Chapter members.
- \$250.00 per entry, non-refundable for other AIA Chapter members.

Only projects submitted between May 1st, 2024, and May 31st, 2024, will be eligible for the early bird submission fee. After May 31st, 2024, the submission fees are as follows:

- \$250.00 per entry, non-refundable for AIA/San Fernando Valley Chapter members.
- \$300.00 per entry, non-refundable for other AIA Chapter members.

One award certificate will be provided to winners. Additional certificates can be requested for an additional charge.

DESIGN AWARDS BANQUET

The banquet will be held in early November. Location to be announced.

Design award presentation will be through PowerPoint.

Exhibition of work (20"x30" display boards) will be presented at the Design Awards Banquet.
